Partnership is key to the success of Childspring International and nowhere is this more evident than in Haiti. Clearly one of the neediest places on earth, here, Childspring helped establish Lespwa Timoun (Creole for "Hope for Children") a nutritional program providing critical, and very often life-saving, sustenance for children on the edge of starvation. Founded in 2002, the program operates around the eastern perimeter of Port-au-Prince offering medicines, an intensive 90-day course of nutritional supplements and unique health education for parents. In August 2009, Childspring provided the resources necessary to form a partnership between Lespwa Timoun and the World Food Program. Childspring provided a facility in eastern Port-au-Prince with clinical rooms, educational space and storage space for the nutritional supplements donated by WFP.
